The Logan Hubble Park is nestled in the northern section of Lincoln County. This park was named in honor of the Logan and Hubble ancestors of William Martin. The Fiscal Courts of Lincoln and Garrard County received ownership through the will of William Martin.

The Logan family settled the area now known as Stanford. A smaller community "Logantown" is located near the Dix River. The Hubble family settled in the rolling farmland area now known as Hubble.

The Logan Hubble Park is located off of Hwy 27. The 400-acre nature park includes wildlife habitats, nearly 2 miles of walking trails and 10 miles of horse trails, 12-acre fishing lake, outdoor class room, basketball courts, playground facilities, volley ball court and picnic areas.

Whether it is for a reunion, picnic or birthday party, shelters are available for \$50. There are four shelters.



One special feature is a horse camp facility with 6 electricity hookups for campers, showers and restrooms.
